At the battle of Lincoln, in February 1141, Hugh Bigod fought beside Stephen but was overthrown and fled Shortly afterwards he treated with Matilda and attended her court If these defaced Norwich and Thetford coins were issued by order of Bigod they were probably struck shortly after the battle of Lincoln, when Bigod went over to Matilda's cause
